



Washington Auto Theft Prevention Authority Regional Auto Theft Training

The Washington Auto Theft Prevention Authority is conducting auto theft training in Everett, Lakewood, Vancouver, Yakima, Kennewick and Spokane. The presenters are King County Deputy Prosecutors Shaya Calvo and Doug Young. They are part of King County's **Car Theft Initiative** and are assigned specifically to vehicle theft prosecution.

Mr. Calvo and Mr. Young will be discussing what prosecutors need to successfully prosecute an auto theft case and how the CTI has reduced vehicle theft in the Central Puget Sound by over 50%. Topics will include processing a recovered stolen vehicle, questions that need to be answered before the detectives take the case, what information to follow-up, following the leads provided by suspects, documentation, photography, statements, preservation of evidence, what is usable evidence, what might be important in the future (fingerprints for example) to link cases and suspects, etc. Also covered will be the use of analysts, identification of an area's prolific (top) thieves and pro-active investigation and enforcement.
